Instructions Scale Definition Score - Know Stroke

Administer stroke scale items in the order listed Record performance in each category after each subscale exam Do not go back and change scores Follow directions provided for each exam technique Scores should reflect what the patient does, not what the clinician thinks the patient can do

SPOT A STROKE F.A.S.T.

SPOT A STROKE FAST FAcE DROOPIng — Does one side of the face droop or is it numb? Ask the person to smile Is the person's smile uneven? ARM WEAKnESS — Is one arm weak or numb? Ask the person to raise both arms Does one arm drift downward? SPEEch DIFFICulTy — Is speech slurred? Is the person unable to speak or hard to

Stroke Markings are Rated Stroke not Adjustment Limit All stroke markings placed on a brake chamber by the manufacturer refer to the rated stroke of the chamber Rated stroke is a design feature and is generally one-half inch (13 millimeters) greater than the brake adjustment limit of a chamber
